### **CMSD Fathers Walk 2025**

August 18, 2025

Dear Educators,

As we continue to build strong partnerships between schools and families, the annual *Fathers Walk* provides an incredible opportunity to showcase the power of fatherhood and male role models in the lives of our scholars. On **Thursday, September 18, 2025**, we will celebrate the **20th Annual Fathers Walk** across Cuyahoga County and CMSD. On this day, thousands of fathers, grandfathers, uncles, brothers, and mentors will walk hand-in-hand with students while also engaging in activities that strengthen connections to school and community.



But the Fathers Walk has always been more than a symbolic walk to school. It is a **transformative experience**—a reminder that when male role models are present, students attend more regularly, engage more deeply, and believe more fully in their potential. Think of it as *Father's Day during the school year*, a moment that honors fathers and father-figures in ways that are often missing in traditional school programming.

This year, as CMSD commits to *Leveling Up* and *Building Brighter Futures*, we invite schools to **reimagine the possibilities**. The Walk is not a one-day event, but a catalyst. Schools have already embraced this initiative through father-child reading circles, school-wide morning meetings, fatherhood brunches, community service projects, and even college-planning boot camps. These activities are models of what family engagement can become: **transformational**, **not transactional**. They open doors to year-long involvement, strengthen relationships, and create culturally responsive spaces where every child can see and feel the impact of positive male engagement.

The Fathers Walk is more than a symbolic event, it is an opportunity to engage families in ways that are **inclusive**, **individualized**, **integrated**, **and impactful**. Unlike our universal approaches to family engagement, this should be planned and executed as a **meaningful**, **targeted experience** that reflects the unique needs of your school community.

In the toolkit, we have provided a **CMSD Action Plan template** to help you get started. The activities outlined are **suggestions**, **not requirements**. Schools are encouraged to **mix and match** from the four sections – *Elementary*, *Middle*, *High School*, *and Multi-Grade* – or design their own experiences that best fit their families.

Pepending on the activity selected, schools may also be eligible to use their federal Title I family engagement allocation to support the purchase of resources. Please check with your Family and Community Engagement Coordinator for guidance.

To ensure the success of this year's Fathers Walk and related activities, consider the following:

- **Promotion:** Share details well in advance through newsletters, flyers, school apps, and social media.
- **Involvement:** Partner with Family Engagement Committees, parent groups, and community organizations to design and deliver activities.
- **Follow-Up:** Provide take-home resources or digital access for families who cannot attend in person.

• **Documentation:** Capture the moment with photos and video. Use sign-in sheets or preregistration to plan effectively for materials and refreshments.

Last year, over **208 schools** across Cuyahoga County participated, with more than **25,000 fathers and father figures walking** alongside children, including more than **85% of CMSD schools.** As we celebrate the 20th anniversary, we aim even higher, ensuring that every school community not only joins in the Walk but also uses it as a launchpad for deeper engagement throughout the year.

Just as important, these strategies should be viewed as **aligned supports** for your school's **Academic Achievement Plan (AAP).** Whether reinforcing literacy and math goals through reading circles and STEM challenges, advancing family engagement priorities through collaborative projects, or preparing scholars for the college-career-workforce pipeline through mentoring and planning sessions, the Fathers Walk and its companion activities provide practical, measurable ways to connect family engagement to academic success.
