Directory Information Opt-Out:

Directory Information includes student's name, address, telephone number(s), date and place of birth, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, achievement awards or honors, student's weight and height if a member of an athletic team, major field of study, dates of attendance and date of graduation.

Directory information can be released to anyone without a parent's written consent unless this form is completed and returned to your child's school. Parents, guardians and adult students have the right to prevent the disclosure of directory information, except as otherwise provided by the Notification of Rights under FERPA for Elementary and Secondary Schools contained in the student code of conduct, pages 14-15.
