The Classroom

Teacher will:

At Home

Parents will:

- Make sure the child is in school and on time. Plan vacations during CMSD vacation calendar.
- Make sure homework is completed and the child is reading daily. When absent child is responsible to complete missing work.
- Stay informed about the child's education and communication with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the district received by the child, via remind messaging, My PoweHub with teachers, or mail/email and responding as appropriate.
- Friendly usage of Social Media Buhrer Platforms Facebook and Instagram.
- Review child's Power School gradebook.
- Monitor the use of electronic devices at home.
- Make sure the child gets age-appropriate amount of sleep.
- Participate in Parent Teacher Conferences.

Scholars

Students will:
