

How can parents support learning this summer?


Kids can experience learning loss during long breaks. "The Summer Slide" seems to be the most infamous and troublesome type of learning loss. Teachers worry that when students return from summer break, that they have to spend more time reviewing than digging into new material. This could potentially delay the start of new curriculum.

One way to support your child's learning this summer is to sign them up for the summer learning experience that the district is providing this year. There will 11 learning sites for students in grades K-5, starting June 10th through July 11th.
