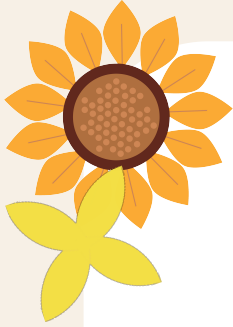


Thankful November

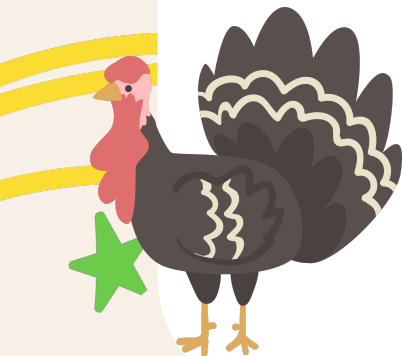


Quarter 2!.

We will raffle off a gift basket and give out PBIS points for those in attendance.



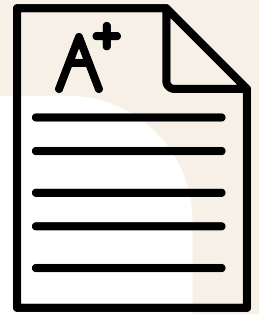

MyPowerHub



Check Your Child's Grades with MyPowerHub.

MyPowerHub is the parent portal end of PowerSchool. PowerSchool is the main database of all student information. It is how the district and each school handles enrollment, attendance, grading and other student data.

MyPowerHub is the portal for parents. This is where we can see attendance data for our kids and their grades in real time. Since the district decided to no longer distribute progress reports throughout the year; parents having access to this portal is of the most importance.

Remote K8 School educators are updating grades every 3

weeks and updating attendance daily. When you create an account and use the app; you will be able to see these updates. If you ever see a grade that is alarming or unexpected, you can have a talk with your child and then have a conference with the teacher to talk about goals and improvement.

I believe that this is one of the most valuable resources we have as parents this school year. Please make sure to utilize it.

Without an account you will only get grade updates at the time of report cards.
